SO, WHAT HAPPENS IN GHANA WITH HOMEOPATHY?

There is little consistent healthcare in Ghana, particularly in rural areas because of the distances to get to a hospital. One of our rural homeopaths who works in a primary healthcare setting where homeopathy is the main activity, told us about dealing with life and death situations and having to choose between two patients, both in critical situations, in the middle of the night. Traditional healers are relied on and integrated into the health system under the Ministry of Health, so homeopathy comes under the traditional healer umbrella. This means that practice is regulated far more stringently than it is in the UK. One of the first tasks has involved ensuring that our recently trained homeopaths have the correct licences and remain within the law. There is even a Roaming Licence for practitioners who run outreach clinics.

Education to practitioner level became a project focus in the last five years as two four-year diploma courses resulted in **TWENTY FOUR GHANAIANS QUALIFYING AS PRACTITIONERS**. This has involved familiarity with regulations for practitioners, planning CPD workshops, identifying and filling gaps in training, as well as supporting and organising supervision for the new homeopaths to make a success of their practice. Clinical work in training was difficult particularly over the time of the pandemic. We are looking forward to having **VOLUNTEERS** coming out to Ghana and supporting the project again and we will be working with them about their needs and expectations to ensure that their stay goes to plan.

So, who are the newly qualified homeopaths? They are a mix of ages. There are some nurses and teachers, others work on the land, farming. Most have not run a business before, though entrepreneurial skills are coming through. Adelaide, a former nurse has talked about homeopathy and natural health on Ghana radio recently. All of them are very passionate about homeopathy. Some have made big sacrifices to train and are getting really good results with cases.

Practitioners are finding their areas of special interest, e.g., one practitioner sees a lot of stroke survivors; he estimates they make up half his practice.

INSPIRING CASES

There are strong feelings among the new practitioners about disabled people being ignored in their society and the potential of homeopathy to help. In the same way, another practitioner is interested in working with people who experience mental illness, again a group which is not well understood or supported in Ghana.

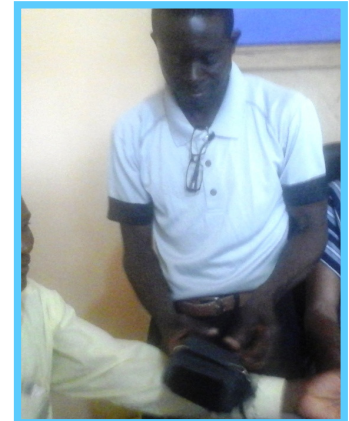
With the vitality of the people, many with few resources, some with advanced pathology; clear remedy pictures and remarkable responses to treatment can often happen.

CASE 1. Prosper, a man of forty-nine with five children, works as a gold miner. For the last 2 years he has fallen into a coma-like state almost every night, often becoming incontinent.

On further questioning, this started when he found out that some of his colleagues had been stealing some of the gold they mined. He remembered becoming angry, collapsing and once even being taken to hospital, but nothing was discovered.

Talking about anger generally, he said he has a quick temper and gets palpitations and his whole body shakes. He was prescribed a dose of Staphisagria 30c and apart from having a mild recurrence on the day of taking the remedy, has been symptom-free ever since.

CASE 2. On a Sunday, a woman of thirty six, visited Emperor with severe vaginal bleeding. About two weeks before the visit, she had suffered an abortion just after the first trimester. There was yellow vomiting and loose stool. Emperor swiftly prescribed Ipecac, which reperforated very well. Quickly the bleeding had reduced and the woman went to bed at the clinic and had fallen asleep – which is usually a very good sign.

With the suspicion that parts of the placenta may have remained in the womb and was the cause of the bleed, it was decided to keep her over-night at the clinic in case of further developments.

At around midnight the husband had called to say she was in severe pain and when Emperor got to the room she was screaming and saying the pain was cramping and she felt something wanting to come out from her vagina like a baby.

Immediately she was given Sepia 200c single dose and the pain quickly reduced. She was left to rest. About an hour later, Emperor was called again and to his surprise saw two big bloody clots in the chamber pot that had come through the vagina. The woman then fell fast asleep with no pain.

In the morning she was taken to see a midwife. The midwife found no more traces of placenta in the uterus. Ipecac and Sepia had cleared all remaining matter.

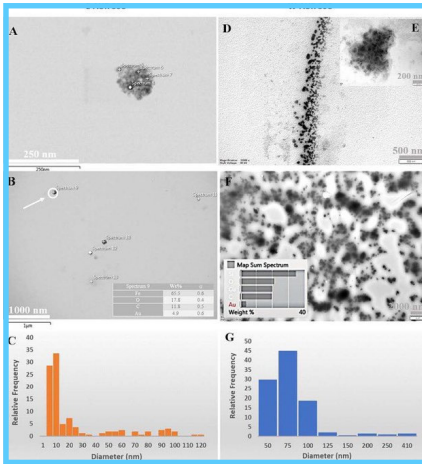
