Brief History: Ghana is quite unique in some ways in Africa since it has quite an active homeopathic community and an existing Ghana Homeopathy Association. The government recognizes homeopathy through the Traditional Medical Practitioners Council and therefore homeopaths are able to practice legally in the country.

The Ghana Homeopathy Project: working under the charity, 'Homeopathy in Africa' has been active in Ghana for 17 years, the project being inspired by its founder Linda Shannon who initially worked with Homeopaths without Borders who were active in West Africa at that time. In its 17years, GHP has supported clinics in different parts of the country and offered educational programmes including a four-year professional training programme as well as many introductory programmes.

New Board of Trustees and Coordinator. In the last two months three new board trustees have joined the project, including Linda Shannon, the original founder of the project. Also, a new coordinator has joined, Richard Pitt, who was previously a coordinator of the project in 2009-2010. New board trustees are, Jacqueline Smith, a previous coordinator between 2014-2017; Sian Alcock and returning trustee Bonsu Boaten, so there is now a wealth of experienced people in the organisation who know Ghana well.



With all this new energy on board, a re-visioning process has taken place, where we are currently looking at how the project will move forward from now on, while building on all the good work done over the years.

GOALS

The following goals have been identified and plans made to move forward on:

- Supporting more than 24 graduates of the professional training programmes into homeopathic practice through professional registration and ongoing mentoring and support.
- Supporting existing homeopathic clinics that have been connected to the project, and giving opportunities for graduates to gain more clinical experience.
- Ensuring that the homeopathic clinics have access to homeopathic remedies and to explore the creation of a homeopathic pharmacy in Ghana that can distribute remedies around Ghana, thereby giving further recognition of homeopathic pharmacy in the country.
- Developing continued professional development (CPD) programmes for graduates to gain further experience.
- Offering mentoring and supervision programmes for graduates.
- Developing an online professional training programme, focused on training existing medical professionals into homeopathy.
